

FAST PITCH AGE DIVISIONS

6U Division (T-Ball)

Players who turn 7 prior to September 1 of the prior year are not eligible unless they are in kindergarten or receive an age exception waiver from the league. Players who are 6u are eligible for this division regardless of their grade. **The 6U Division will be Co-Ed.**

8U Division

Players who turn 9 prior to September 1 of the prior year are not eligible unless they are in the 2nd grade or receive an age exception waiver from the league. Players who are 8u are eligible for this division regardless of their grade.

10U Division

Players who turn 11 prior to September 1 of the prior year are not eligible unless they are in the 4th grade or receive an age exception waiver from the league. Players who are 10u are eligible for this division regardless of their grade.

12U Division

Players who turn 13 prior to September 1 of the prior year are not eligible unless they are in the 6th grade or receive an age exception waiver from the league. Players who are 12u are eligible for this division regardless of their grade.

14U Division

Players who turn 15 prior to September 1 of the prior year are not eligible unless they are in the 8th grade or receive an age exception waiver from the league. Players who are 14u are eligible for this division regardless of their grade.

16U Division

Players who turn 17 prior to September 1 of the prior year are not eligible unless they are a sophomore in High School or receive an age exception waiver from the league. Players who are 16u are eligible for this division regardless of their grade.

*** In divisions 6U – 16U, all players participating in tournament play shall always have photocopies of their original birth certificate and any age exception waivers, in the possession of their team manager. Upon protest, failure to have a photocopy of the original birth certificate immediately available upon demand shall result in the offending team losing the game(s), being ejected from the tournament, being placed last in the standings, and forfeiting all awards, points, and berths that would have been or have been awarded.

*** **In addition to a copy of their birth certificate** all grade-based players must have a copy of a current report card, official school ID with grade, or any official government document stating their grade.

If a particular age division does not have enough players to field a team, an in-between division (I.E. 9u, 11u, 13u, 15u) or a combination of ages division (I.E. 8/10u, 10/12u, 14/16u) may be established. Any alternate age division league must be approved by the Board with an alternate set of game rules established and voted on.

Players may play up with the following limitations: For player safety, liability, and to maintain competitive integrity, players may play up a maximum of one age level.
